## "Public places/private spaces: investigations by contemporary artists"

The personal is political, the forceful 20th Century feminist slogan, insists on the interdependence of private and public space and continues to encourage vital contemporary art strategies. The demarcating line between public and private space follows cultural and social changes and is contested, always, sometimes hotly, with questions of gender at its core. I will discuss how contemporary feminist art projects intervene in this vital territory. Particular focus will be on the Copenhagen-based feminist artists' collective Women down the Pub. Their interventions in public space question notions of gender, history writing and representations of power, most often involving an "ordinary public", outside of the traditional modern art institutions.
